I HAVE VISITED THE CAMP AT ORR SEVERAL TIMES IN THE PAST THREE YEARS, BUT IT SEEMS THAT DURING MY PRESENCE THERE, THE MUSIC WAS CHANGED.

MANY GOOD THINGS HAVE BEEN ACCOMPLISHED AT THE ORR MINNESOTA SEP CAMP, AND HUNDREDS OF YOUTHS HAVE BEEN HELPED AND LIVES CHANGED. BUT IN THIS AREA OF MUSIC DAMAGE HAS BEEN DONE.
